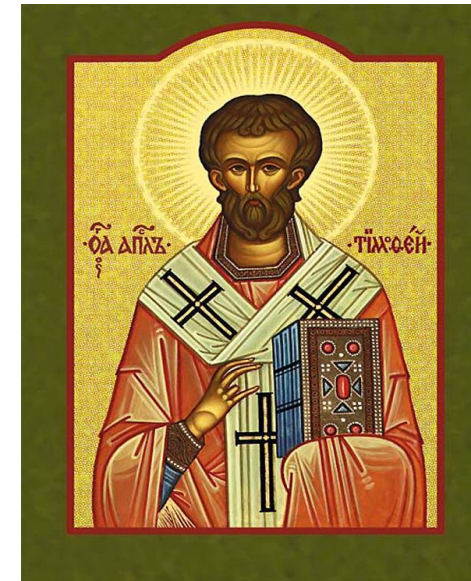
1. It's all about leadership
