

The Proclamation of the Word

First Reading: Genesis 17:1-7, 15-16 (Kate Turcotte)

Bible p. 13 OT

Psalm 22

- 1 My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? *
Why so far from saving me, So far from the words of my groaning?
- 2 My God, I cry by day, but you do not answer; * by night but I find no rest.
- 3 Yet you are the Holy One, * enthroned upon the praises of Israel.
- 4 Our ancestors put their trust in you; * they trusted, and you rescued them.
- 5 They cried out to you and were delivered; *
they trusted in you and were not put to shame.
- 6 But as for me, I am a worm and not human, *
scorned by all and despised by the people.
- 7 All who see me laugh me to scorn; * they curl their lips and shake their heads.
- 8 “Trust in the Lord; let the Lord deliver; *
let God rescue him, if God so delights in him.”
- 9 Yet you are the One who drew me forth from the womb, *
and kept me safe on my mother’s breast.
- 10 I have been entrusted to you ever since I was born; *
you were my God when I was still in my mother’s womb.
- 11 Be not far from me, for trouble is near, * and there is no one to help.
- 12 Many young bulls encircle me; * strong bulls of Bashan surround me.
- 13 They open wide their jaws at me, * like a slashing and roaring lion.
- 14 I am poured out like water; all my bones are out of joint; *
my heart within my breast is melting wax.
- 15 My mouth is dried out like a pot-sherd; my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth; *
and you have laid me in the dust of death.
- 16 Packs of dogs close me in, a band of evildoers circles round me; *
they pierce my hands and my feet; I can count all my bones.
- 17 They stare at me and gloat; *
they divide my garments among them; for my clothing, they cast lots.
- 18 But you, O Lord, be not far away; * O my help, hasten to my aid.
- 19 Deliver me from the sword, * my life from the power of the dog.
- 20 Save me from the lion’s mouth, *
from the horns of wild bulls you have rescued me.
- 21 I will declare your name to my people; *
in the midst of the congregation I will praise you.
- 22 You who fear the Lord, give praise!; *
All you of Jacob’s line, give glory.
Stand in awe of the Lord, all you offspring of Israel.

- 23 For the Lord does not despise nor abhor the poor in their poverty;
neither is the Lord's face hidden from them; *
but when they cry out, the Lord hears them.
- 24 From you comes my praise in the great assembly; *
I will perform my vows in the sight of those who fear the Lord.
- 25 The poor shall eat and be satisfied, Let those who seek the Lord give praise: *
"May your heart live for ever!"
