The Proclamation of the Word

First Reading: **Isaiah 1:1, 10-20** (Maribeth Mainer)

Bible p. 630 OT

Psalm 52:

- 1 The Mighty one, God the Lord, has spoken; *
calling the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.
- 2 Out of Zion, perfect in its beauty, * God shines forth in glory.
- 3 Our God will come and will not keep silence; *
with a consuming flame before, and round about a raging storm.
- 4 God calls the heavens and the earth from above *
to witness the judgement of the people.
- 5 “Gather before me my loyal followers, *
those who have made a covenant with me and sealed it with sacrifice.”
- 6 Let the heavens declare the rightness of God’s cause; * for it is God who is judge.
- 7 “Listen, my people, and I will speak: Israel, I will bear witness against you; *
for I am God, your God.
- 8 I do not accuse you because of your sacrifices; * your offerings are always before me.
- 9 I will not accept a calf from your stalls, * nor goats from your pens;
- 10 For all the wild animals of the forest are mine, * the cattle on a thousand hills.
- 11 I know every bird of the mountains, * and the creatures of the fields are mine.
- 12 If I were hungry, I would not tell you, *
for the whole world is mine and all that is in it.


